DISCUSSION GUIDE

MOUNT MORIAH

Introduction:

When God invites us to a "mountain top", it's an invitation to change our perspective through an encounter with God, which in turn impacts our lives. This invitation to come to the mountaintop and encounter God comes to us every day. Sometimes the mountains are big, sometimes they are small, but everyone is offered the opportunity to see the world differently and grow in our faith.

Genesis 22, James 1:13-15, Hebrews 11:17-19, John 8:56, Romans 12:1, Psalm 9:10, Romans 4:19

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What stood out to you from this week's message?
- 2. Share a time when your faith was really tested.
- 3. **Read James 1:13-15**. How are testing and temptation different? How do you know which one it is?
- 4. Andy said two things about worship:
 - Worship should cost us something.
 - Worship reminds us of God's promises.

How are those things true or not in your life? Why do you think that?

- 5. **Read Romans 4:19.** Sometimes the road to receiving a promise from God can seem just as absurd as the promise itself. In your life what has felt absurd in the beginning, but in the end made sense? What key lessons did you learn throughout that journey?
- 6. **Read Hebrews 11:17-19**. Abraham had extraordinary faith that allowed him to believe that if he sacrificed Isaac, the Lord would raise him from the dead. The belief released Abraham from fear, doubt, worry, etc. What is something in your life that you need to release to the Lord, trusting that if God takes it away, even something more miraculous could happen? How do we as Christians gain and live out that type of faith?
- 7. **Read Psalm 9:10.** Our goal as Christians should not be to understand all of the Lord's plans, but to know the One that makes the plans. Explain?

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
