## 7 QUESTIONS: DO YOU BELIEVE THAT I CAN DO THIS?

### Icebreaker:

1. Would you describe yourself as gullible or cynical? Why?

### Passage:

Matthew 9:27-30, Hebrews 11:6

### Context:

This series is called “7 Questions”. There are questions that go way deeper and can completely change the direction of your life. Sometimes the best way to find what you’re looking for doesn’t come from you asking a good question, it’s actually being on the other side of one and having an answer for someone else. Especially, if that question comes from Jesus.

### Discussion Questions:

2. What stood out to you most from this message? Looking back at your notes from last Sunday's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
3. Read Matthew 9:27-31
4. What is significant about the title the blind men use for Jesus?
5. How do they show faith?
6. Why did Jesus warn the men who had been blind not to say anything?
7. How do you define the word faith? How would you distinguish between faith and trust?
8. What does a non-believer have faith in?
9. Give some examples of when you, as a Christian, put your faith in something other than God.
10. What do you do when your faith in something else conflicts with your faith in God?
11. Andy said that there are three things that “faith is”, what did he say?
12. Which one of these catches you most at this point in your life? Why?

### Next Step:

13. In what we talked about, what is the one next step you are going to take this week to move a little closer to who God wants you to become?

### Prayer:

Take some time to pray for our faith. A man said to Jesus, I have faith, but help my unbelief. Jesus helped this man, let’s ask Jesus to help our unbelief this week.
