# DISCUSSION GUIDE

#### WHEN IN ROME...STARTING POINT

## RRC Core Value: AN EMPTY SEAT IS A SERIOUS THING

#### Icebreaker:

- 1. When you write a letter, are you more likely to write until you run out of paper, or keep it short and to the point?
- 2. What is one place that you have never seen that you want to visit?

## Passage:

Romans 1:1-17

#### Context:

In this passage, Paul includes his opening salutation (1-7), thanksgiving (8-15), and his statement of the overall theme of Romans (16-17).

## **Discussion Questions**

- 3. What stood out to you most from this message? Were there any questions that you had after listening to Chad's message?
- 4. How did we define "the Gospel of God" this week? How has that differed from your definition previously?
- 5. What truths about Jesus does Paul proclaim in this passage?
- 6. Where can you see the "obedience that comes from faith" in your own life?
- 7. Chad shared 3 "I am statements" that Paul expresses, talk through them.
- 8. What's the "good news" of the gospel that made Paul eager to share it?
- 9. Paul says, "I am not ashamed of the gospel..." Where are you with this statement? In what situations do you find yourself being ashamed?
- 10. Re-read v17. There are several important theological phrases in this verse. Talk through each of them together.
- 11. Think about a sin you struggle with. How are you rejecting the gospel when you sin in that way? How will believing the gospel transform the next struggle you face?

## **Next Step:**

- 12. Let the gospel grow **deeper** in you. What are you doing this week to take a step in letting the gospel go deeper in you?
- 13. Let the gospel grow **wider** through you. Who's your one? How will you invest in that relationship this week?

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
