I DON'T GET IT – GOD'S WILL

Icebreaker:

1. People love makeover shows, especially the big reveals, whether it is people or houses. What has been the coolest “reveal” in your life?

Passage:

Revelation

Context:

This series is called “I Don’t Get It”. Over the next 5 weeks, we’re going to look at some things that cause people to ask questions or wonder if what they believe about some things is actually what the Bible really says about it.

Discussion Questions

2. What stood out to you most from this message? Looking back at your notes from last Sunday's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
3. Andy said the most important thing about studying the book of Revelation is that we know the main point, Jesus. Why is this so important? What happens if He isn't the main point? Is that different from other books of the Bible?
4. What do you think about when you think about Jesus?
5. Read Revelation 1:12-18.
6. How would it change your world (Prayers, Faith, etc.) to see Jesus this way?
7. Andy gave us 3 tips for reading Revelation:
Be Curious, Be Careful, Keep Christ at the Center
8. Read Revelation 4, while practicing the tips.
9. What are some things that stand out to you from this chapter?
10. Where do we see Jesus in this part of the Revelation?

Next Step:

11. In what we talked about, what response do we have for God that will play itself out this week?

Prayer:

Take some time this week to thank God for revealing His plans. Ask God for help in understanding what we talked about this week. Pray for opportunities to share what we have learned with others.
