DISCUSSION GUIDE

AS TOLD BY JESUS - THE WORKERS

Key Scriptures: Matthew 20:1-16

Discussion Questions: (Use as many as you want)

- 1. Read Matthew 20:1-16 again. What do you notice first?
- 2. What is your reaction to the story? Indifferent, Angry? Why?
- 3. Imagine you were one of the early risers. How did you feel at first when the latecomers were given a day's wage? How did you feel later on when you were paid the same thing?
- 4. Suppose you were one of the latecomers? How did you feel about the situation?
- 5. What do you think about the owner of the vineyard? Is he just? Generous? A good businessman?
- 6. Is Jesus trying to teach us how to run a business?
- 7. Who do the different characters in the story represent?
- 8. What do you think is the main point Jesus was trying to make?
- 9. What do you think he meant by the phrase, "Many that are last shall be first, and the first last?" How does this relate to the kingdom of heaven?
- 10. Is it better to be an early riser or a late comer in the kingdom of heaven?
- 11. Who do you identify with in the story the early risers? the late comers? Why?
- 12. What type of person needs to hear this story the most? What do you think Jesus' intent was in telling it?
- 13. How would you apply this story to your life?

Next Steps:

At the end of the service, Chad challenged us with a guided prayer (ACT) to change the focus of our prayers. As a group, make a commitment to pray this way this week. Then prepare to come back and discuss the impact praying this way had on you.
